#### **Who was Abigail Adams?**

Abigail was the wife of John Adams, a lawyer from Massachusetts. Abigail was educated at home, and extremely well-read. She was a great advocate of basic women's rights and an abolitionist. She and John wrote many letters to each other, in which they had many intelligent conversations about politics and the world. #### **What is a 'Stomacher'?**

A stomacher was a decorated, triangular piece of fabric that was separate from a dress in the Colonial period. Stomachers were often pinned onto the stays, over which the dress would be fastened. A stomacher would often be quilted or boned and was usually highly decorated.
